Improv/History – The Royals (9:00 am Elementary; 10:30 am Jr. High & High School)

History comes alive when you get to BE the characters! Each week students will hear a story of royal intrigue- plots and prisoners, love and lunacy. Using fun and easy improv basics, they will jump up on their feet and act out these stories and understand history from the point of view of the people that lived it. There is no writing requirement!

Explore history in a more exciting and fulfilling way.

Please note, that this class takes a creative approach to exploring history. It does address historical issues, events and persons that may be considered controversial. Much Ado makes every effort to keep the classroom material age-appropriate. However, it cannot adapt class content to match individual family sensibilities.

Stage Combat - Hand to Hand & Sword (2:30-4:00 pm)

This fun and physical series of workshops will challenge students to develop new levels of body awareness, safety skills and teamwork. Students will explore stage combat technique through a combination of such possible skills as: hand-to-hand, rapier, dagger, switchblade, pike or broadsword.
